MINUTE ORDER

The following minute order is made at the direction of the Court, the Honorable James P. Donohue, United States Magistrate Judge:

This matter comes before the Court upon the filing of petitioner’s Emergency Motion for Conditional Release Pending Final Determination, Dkt. 45, and Petitioner’s Brief Regarding Jurisdiction Over the Habeas Petition, Dkt. 46. Petitioner’s emergency motion can be most efficiently addressed within the expedited briefing schedule previously set by the Court’s Order dated February 17, 2017. Dkt. 39. However, in order to ensure that the government has adequate time to respond to petitioner’s emergency motion, the deadline for the government’s motion to dismiss on jurisdictional grounds is extended from Friday, February 24, 2017 to **Monday, February 27, 2017 at 5:00 p.m.**, and the government shall incorporate any response to petitioner’s emergency motion for conditional release into its

1 motion to dismiss. Similarly, petitioner shall incorporate any additional argument in support of  
2 his emergency motion for conditional release into his response to the government's motion to  
3 dismiss. **All other deadlines previously set by the Court shall remain unchanged.**

5 to the Honorable Ricardo S. Martinez.
