Thanks Claire. It's not too late, it has not been finalized, but your changes fundamentally alter the objective of the resolution. This strips out all of the language that I felt was so important to guide the Council in decision-making – specifically so future decisions about the ordinance aren't made for political reasons, but for legal ones. The intent was to shield those decisions A-E in the resolution from the kind of lobbying that might, in the near future, lead Councilmembers to legislate a legally weak bill to address concerns of various groups. I'll speak with Newell some more, but I think if we remove this language we may be missing a strategic opportunity.
